

1 thing, Zenaida, Jeffrey Hopkins, the whole story. Saying he had all the e-mails,  
2 which I know what he forwarded to you. Because he, actually he printed them off  
3 that night while I was there. We sat there, finally Lee said, "Look, I don't know  
4 what's going on but I'm really tired. It's 1045, I got to go." George comes out of  
5 a back room at about 1105 in his shorts. Kind of shocked to see me. And I'm  
6 thinking, I just drove a long way. "Oh, uh, I'm really sorry. I got delayed." And  
7 I'm sitting there thinking, I'm trying not to get angry because of the situation....

8 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

9 **RG:** ...but I'm kind of insulted to be honest with you. Okay, I, I cut him some slack.  
10 Uhm, so you know uh, uh, you know, he starts hemming and hawing and I'm, I'm  
11 thinking, "What's going on here?" And uhm, Cindy didn't really talk to me. Cindy  
12 and I, I'm not a fan of Cindy's and Cindy knows it. So she pretty much kept away  
13 from me. The only thing I did hear her say that night that I thought was  
14 interesting, she said it to my wife but I was standing right there, she, the only  
15 thing she said that night that I thought was even human was, in truth, was, "You  
16 know I could lose both my girls on this one."

17 **YM:** Hmm.

18 **RG:** First sign that she had a clue that something was wrong.

19 **YM:** Now how did you discuss that with Lee with her in the room or how, how did she  
20 make that statement, or why....

21 **RG:** Uhm....

22 **YM:** ...well under what context?

23 **RG:** She, uh, you know, my wife and her hit it off just when the baby was born. Uhm,  
24 uh, you know it didn't, it, it came out of nowhere. It was just one of those  
25 emotional that seeped out kind of things. Uhm, yeah (affirmative), but it stuck

1 with me and with my wife. But then as we were going to the car, because now  
2 it's 1115 and I got to go home, George walks me out to the car and I started  
3 asking him questions. He said, "Oh, no, no, I wanted to talk to you but you know  
4 uh, something came up and I forgot that you were there." And uhm, of course I  
5 didn't believe any of that. I mean you asked me to come talk to you. So he said,  
6 "What do you think's going on?" I said, "George, here's where I'm working from  
7 right now." I said, "I have two theories. Something happened and Casey has  
8 snapped. This isn't Casey anymore. Or Casey got involved in something that  
9 went wrong and either she's hidden Caylee or somebody's taken Caylee." And  
10 that's the one he was leaning towards. Uhm, and I said, you know, "George  
11 what, what's, what's your daugh...what has your daughter got involved in?" He  
12 goes, "I don't know. You know because Casey's always had issues." That's  
13 always been, that's always his statement, "Casey has issues." Uhm, and then I,  
14 we talked about the smell in the trunk and I said, "If it's not Caylee George who is  
15 it?" He said, "I don't know. I don't know." And I said, then I said point blank, I  
16 said, "George what is your daughter gotten herself into?" I said, "Because I'm  
17 just starting and I'm starting to find things I don't like about Fusion and some of  
18 these people she's hanging out with." I said, "Something's really wrong." I said,  
19 "Casey's life is, is in my opinion not good. But it's a controlled mess up until the  
20 end of May, early June. Something happens to spin that out of control." Uhm,  
21 he said, "Yeah (affirmative), you know I don't know. It's this new crowd." And  
22 then uh, he, he just kind of blurted out about the whole job thing. He said, "You  
23 know we, well I knew that she didn't have any of these jobs." He said, "She,  
24 when she told us she worked at the Sports Authority I, I went there one day.  
25 They told me she'd never been there. And I discovered most of the jobs that

1 she's told us she had she never had." Which and of course I made a not of that  
2 means you knew she wasn't working. So if she has a nanny who's paying for  
3 her? Uhm, the thing that struck me when I was reading those notes about her  
4 story about Zenaida it hasn't changed word for word since April of '06.

5 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

6 **RG:** It's still exactly the same story. Uhm, when she told it to us, I think I told you on  
7 the phone, uh, from the end of her, a baby, her babysitter at that point was  
8 Lauren Gibbs.

9 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

10 **RG:** Lauren suddenly couldn't do it anymore. I think she was going back to school.  
11 Now she has no babysitter for Caylee and she's supposedly working at Kodak, at  
12 Universal.

13 **YM:** And this is when again?

14 **RG:** This is uh, this is March, April and part of May '06.

15 **YM:** Okay.

16 **RG:** Okay? So Jesse decides to give up his only day off from Progressive. He's  
17 watching her on Mondays. And then it got to the point where somebody else in  
18 my family is watching her two days a week. So now Caylee's at our house three  
19 days out of the week during work. I think Casey's there at night and on the  
20 weekends. I don't have a problem with that because Caylee's a wonderful little  
21 girl. But I work out of my house and this was a severe disruption to me. So I  
22 began to press Caylee about, "Have you found anybody yet?" And then when  
23 she finally said she found someone, as I told you on the phone it was really odd.  
24 Rather than just saying, "Yeah (affirmative), I've got that worked out," "Oh, yeah  
25 (affirmative), I found this lady uh, Zenaida Gonzalez and she, she watches my

1 friend Jeffrey Hopkins son Zachery. And Zachery and Caylee play together and  
2 they, they love to be together. So this'll work out great." I'm thinking, "Wow  
3 that's a whole lot more information than I really needed." And by this point I  
4 picked up that Casey likes to tell stories. Uhm, we started to all pick up that  
5 Casey had a little problem with exaggeration. Uhm, so that was one thing that  
6 struck me. The other thing that struck me is this whole story that Cindy and  
7 Casey are best friends. Uhm, I can tell you, and will testify to the fact that Casey  
8 sat at our table over those months when Jesse wasn't there to talk to me and  
9 repeatedly said, "I don't want to turn out like my mother. I don't want to be  
10 around my mother. I want out of that house." Uhm, she hated her father for the  
11 whole gambling thing and uhm, she even tried to get Jesse to move into a house  
12 before they got married. That's how bad she wanted out. But the reason that  
13 didn't happen is because I told Jesse, "If you do that I won't perform the  
14 ceremony." I said, "If you want me to perform your ceremony you can't live  
15 together beforehand." Otherwise she would have hooked him into doing that. So  
16 she wanted out of that house badly. She didn't like her mother. Didn't like her  
17 father. Now that may have changed in two years, but that was pretty adamant  
18 then. Uhm, so my take on George that night was he must have told his wife that  
19 I was coming over and she put the kibosh on it, or something frightened him.  
20 Because we went in a seven hour period of time of going, I want to talk to you. I  
21 got stuff I want to tell you, to avoiding me.

22 **YM:** Hmm.

23 **JA:** Hmm.

24 **RG:** When attorney Walsh slandered Jesse on TV I called George. I wanted to know  
25 was he in on this. Left a message. I said, "George, I'm a little ticked right now.

1 Please call me back.” The phone rang and his caller i.d. (identification) comes  
2 up and it’s Cindy. “George is a little busy to talk to you. What’s the problem?” I  
3 said, “I’ll tell you what’s the problem.” I made a mistake. I was angry. I should  
4 have said, “No, I want to talk to George,” but I didn’t do that. And I went off on  
5 Cindy. And we had an interesting conversation. Uh, I told her what the lawyer  
6 said. “Well I don’t know anything about that.” And I said, “Look, you know what  
7 Cindy, all bets are off. Anybody asks me a direct question about your daughter  
8 I’m going to give them a direct answer. “ I said, “I’m not hiding anything.” And  
9 that’s when she began to proceed, “Well your son’s no angel either.” Said, “I  
10 think, I think he’s involved somehow.” Those were her exact words. That  
11 afternoon I had spoken to Corporal Williams....

12 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

13 **RG:** Is that...and you know, we were trying to figure out how everybody was putting  
14 Jesse in the middle of it, and Corporal Williams said, “Well I’ll tell you where you  
15 need to look.” He said, “Cindy Anthony dropping your son’s name left and right.”  
16 And he said to me, “She’s telling people he’s involved somehow.” So when  
17 Cindy repeated to me word for word what Corporal Williams said, I said, “You  
18 know what Cindy? I was talking to somebody in the Sheriff’s Office this  
19 afternoon and they told me you would say that word for word.” And so I, uh, she,  
20 I said, “You know what Cindy here’s what I don’t understand. You’re talking how  
21 special your daughter is.” I said, “She ripped Jesse off for two hundred and fifty  
22 dollars. He paid a phone bill for her and she gave Jesse a bad check.” Her  
23 response was, “Well she only did it once.”

24 **YM:** (Sighs.)

25 **RG:** Saying well I guess it’s okay, it was only once.

1 **YM:** Huh.

2 **RG:** And then I said, "but you know what Cindy? Here's even worse. You knew Jesse  
3 was not the father of that baby. And the reason I know that is because George  
4 told me so. When the DNA evidence came in he admitted that you both knew  
5 the math didn't work." I said, "So you were going to allow him to take the fall for  
6 a baby that wasn't his." And I said, "And even that he was still going to marry  
7 your daughter and raise Caylee as his own." And her exact words were, "Well  
8 nobody put a gun to his head."

9 **YM:** (Sighs.)

10 **RG:** And I went, "You know what Cindy? This conversation's over." I said, "You won't  
11 be hearing from me again. We're done." That told me right then and there a  
12 couple of things in my opinion. Cindy's probably as delusional as Casey is. But  
13 it also told me that right and wrong was irrelevant. The ends justify the means,  
14 which is why I think we are where we are now with numerous people coming  
15 back to me and saying they're working hard to frame your son. Uh, somebody  
16 from Fox News called and told me that. All of Padilla's people have called me up  
17 and said, "You, you, you better get on the move here. They are actively trying to  
18 frame your son."

19 **YM:** When was your last conversation with uh, any of the Anthony family? Was it that  
20 one with Cindy?

21 **RG:** No. Actually I'd been talking to Lee. Remember I....

22 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

23 **RG:** I mentioned to you that uhm, I had offered Lee somebody to talk to. Now he'd  
24 been, he'd been using Jesse as somebody to talk to because he was frustrated.  
25 Uhm, so then he started talking to uh, myself. And after a couple of

1 conversations I told Jesse, I said, "Jesse, I got a bad feeling we're being played."  
2 He said, "You, do you think that Lee's playing all ends from the middle?" I said,  
3 "From the last conversation I had I'm, I'm starting to question why he's so friendly  
4 with us and why he's telling us what he's telling us." Because he was telling me,  
5 well you know Lee would come right out and say, "My parents are out of control.  
6 We make a plan what we're not going to do. We get outside," I mean he was not  
7 being complimentary towards his parents. And the last couple of conversations  
8 he said, "Guy's I'm completely out of the loop. I don't even know what's going on  
9 around here."

10 **YM:** When was the last conversation you had with Lee?

11 **RG:** I spoke to him two weeks ago. And the reason I remember that is somebody  
12 from Fox News called me up and says there's a name uh, we don't know who he  
13 is. And I said, "Who's that?" Alright, they said, "Somebody named Kyle." I said,  
14 "I never heard the name before." They said, "Some, everybody's hot on this  
15 Kyle. See what you can find out." I called up Lee and I said, "Lee who's is there  
16 a Kyle involved in Casey's life?" I said, "Because he's not in my notes." "Well  
17 yeah (affirmative), there's two or three of them, and one's a close, family friend."  
18 I said, "Well could uhm, could you give me a name?" And he goes, "Well let me  
19 see who they're talking about," and he never called me back but he did  
20 something really interesting. He blocked me out from Casey's My Space profile.  
21 Up 'til that afternoon I had access to all her comments, which I've been saving  
22 and adding to my notes, had access to all her friends. That afternoon asking him  
23 about this Kyle, I'm suddenly blocked. I can't get back into her profile.

24 **YM:** Hmm.

25 **RG:** And that was the last time I spoke to Lee.

1 **YM:** And that was the last time you spoke to anyone in the Anthony family?

2 **RG:** Yes. Now the last time I commu...communicated with Lee was by a text  
3 message. Uhm, and it was just something I felt led to do. He had gone to do the  
4 Trenton Duckett vigil and I just....

5 **YM:** That was the night that uh, Casey was coming home, wasn't it?

6 **RG:** Right, I think so. And I sent him a text message and said, "Look, for what it's  
7 worth," I said, "I'm proud of the way you've handled yourself." I said, and uh, "I, I  
8 think you're a good young man. Just keep doing what you're doing." His  
9 message back, and I still have it, was, he said, "You don't know how much that  
10 means to me." I don't, I don't think his father tells him stuff like that. And you  
11 know I don't, again, my opinion, I think Lee's a good kid. I think he's in a lousy  
12 family.

13 **JA:** Hmm.

14 **YM:** What has Jesse told you about what's going on? What's his understanding  
15 about what's going on? I know that you've, you've talked to your son. You and  
16 your son....

17 **RG:** Right.

18 **YM:** ....have a close relationship.

19 **RG:** Right. We have a, uh, almost every conversation he's had with Lee he's come  
20 and share with me.

21 **YM:** What does he think is happening?

22 **RG:** In you mean in, in the case?

23 **YM:** Well as far as what, what does he, what does he perceive the family's doing?  
24 Well what's his take on this whole thing?

25 **RG:** What uh....



1 **YM:** What has he told you?

2 **RG:** Okay, the take is, and we, we both are, are in agreement that something  
3 changed. Well first of all C...we, we know Cindy's not, oh, I'm sorry, forgive me  
4 for saying that. Her story's never stayed the same. But the longer we go into  
5 this just the more they circle the wagons and the more the story gets honed in,  
6 uhm, I, I held out hope from the beginning that Caylee was alive. I really  
7 believed that Casey had stashed her somewhere or somebody took her. Uhm,  
8 and the reason for that is, and I don't know, what your spiritual beliefs are, but  
9 on, I can tell you when it was because I still have my notes. On Friday, July 25<sup>th</sup>,  
10 at 2:25 p.m. I was praying with somebody on the phone and I had what's called  
11 an open vision. And here's what an open vision is in uh, Christian faith. I could  
12 be sitting here looking at you, but I wouldn't be seeing you. I'd be seeing  
13 something else. And this is what I saw in the vision. I saw Caylee asleep on her  
14 right side. I saw sand and dirt shavings. I knew water was over here because I  
15 could smell it. And I saw a gray house here. And it looked like she was sleeping.  
16 She was just totally motionless on her right side. And then in the vision I saw  
17 what appeared to be a very large man. And in my notes I wrote human or angel,  
18 I don't know, who reached down with his right hand and took her by his left, and  
19 walked away. So I wrote all that down. The person pray with, praying with me  
20 saw almost everything I saw. When I, I did a U-Tube tribute to, to Caylee. And  
21 when I downloaded two pictures off of Casey's profile, one of Caylee sitting in the  
22 little sandbox, and one near the playhouse, I almost barfed on my computer  
23 because I realized what I was looking at. I was looking at what I saw in the  
24 vision. And what I wrote in my notes, and I told Jesse is, if anything happened to  
25 Caylee that's where it happened. And I don't know where the dogs hit on, but

1 that's what I saw. Uhm, but I was holding out hope that maybe the guy walking  
2 her away was somebody that came and took her because from what I've heard  
3 from friends and also from Jesse, Casey had a habit of when guys would come  
4 over to the house, Mom and Dad weren't home, she'd leave Caylee unattended  
5 to be with them. And in Jesse's case Caylee's a baby in a crib. I could tell  
6 you....

7 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

8 **RG:** ...I still read him the riot act for that. I said, "You don't do that." Older, that's big  
9 trouble. That's, that would, that's big trouble. Uh, as far as Casey as a mother,  
10 what I saw she seemed to be a doting, loving mother. And I may have said this  
11 to you in my first e-mail. Caylee was the center of Casey's life. Without Caylee  
12 she has no self-worth and she has no value and she has no way to manipulate  
13 friends and family to bail her out.

14 **YM:** Did Casey ever tell you anything about her and her mother in regards to who was  
15 the better mother for Caylee? Like did her mother ever threaten her, uh, saying  
16 you're, you're worthless. You need to listen to me? Anything along those sort  
17 of...?

18 **RG:** Not that early in the game. The, there obviously were issues. Uh, when we went  
19 over for the family barbecue to introduce the families, it was obviously who lead  
20 dog was. Lead dog is Cindy. And whatever she wanted to have happen  
21 happened. And if she wanted Caylee to do something that's what got done.  
22 Uhm, I never, I never heard that. The only thing that I heard from Jesse is when  
23 the fights began, the fights began over Caylee. The fights began with, "You love  
24 Caylee more than you love me. The only reason you're marrying me is because  
25

1 of Caylee." So this jealousy I'm hearing now makes sense because she had it  
2 then.

3 **YM:** Did she ever mention this uh, to you uh, oh, aside from Zeniada, did she ever  
4 mention Juliet Lewis to you as a friend....

5 **RG:** No.

6 **YM:** ...of hers, or this Jeff Hopkins....

7 **RG:** Yes.

8 **YM:** ...with, with Zach?

9 **RG:** Y...yes. That was that, the introduction....

10 **YM:** (Inaudible) Zenaida, aside from (inaudible).

11 **RG:** ...the whole Zenaida thing.

12 **YM:** Have you ever met any of these people?

13 **RG:** No sir. No sir.

14 **YM:** Had, do you, have you ever, uh, do you recall ever being present in the room  
15 with her while she's talking to one of these people or, or, or say hey, uh, hi  
16 Zenaida, how are you? Anything like that?

17 **RG:** No. At that time, no. No, uh....

18 **YM:** Any other time?

19 **RG:** No. Uhm...

20 **YM:** Do you know if Jesse has ever been in the room, or if Jesse ever told you he's  
21 met any of these people?

22 **RG:** No. No, in fact when she came in with the whole Zenaida thing, the same story.  
23 He'd never met her before and never heard of her before. And never met Jeff.  
24 Uhm, these were all names that Casey gave us.  
25

1 **YM:** Did uhm, did he ever tell you about any conversations he may have had with  
2 her? Uhm, well actually during the time that she went missing where, where  
3 Casey might have reached out to him and then asked her for advice or an  
4 opinion....

5 **RG:** Right.

6 **YM:** ...or said, hey, you know, uh, has he ever mentioned anything like that to you?

7 **RG:** Well I asked. And you know I wanted to know. I, and I'll be honest with you. I  
8 wanted him to stay away from her. As much as I have compassion for Casey, as  
9 much as I have uh, as much mercy as I can muster uhm, Casey hurt, hurt the  
10 family. She used us. She took advantage of us. Uhm, the word betrayal came  
11 up and I found it interesting that's what in Cindy's blog. Uhm, so when this, when  
12 Caylee went missing and Casey would reach out to him he would tell me. Like  
13 the time she came over to take the shower.

14 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

15 **RG:** Uhm, is roommate's a friend of mine because I helped him get in there.

16 **YM:** What's his roommate's name?

17 **RG:** Rick Oswald.

18 **YM:** Okay.

19 **RG:** He's a member of my ministry.

20 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

21 **RG:** He's also uhm, my (unintelligible) fifth, fifth degree black belt. Uhm, he had told  
22 me about meeting her. And I said, "Jesse, don't you find it odd that Casey shows  
23 up at ten thirty in the morning and needs to take a shower?" I said, "What do you  
24 think she was doing there?" "Well I think she was trying to seduce me." "Well  
25 what'd you do?" And he said, "I got away from her and played X-Box." And I

1 said, "Son, I don't think that's what she was doing." He said, "What do you think  
2 she was doing?" I said, "I think she was looking for something of yours and if she  
3 needs a scapegoat you're going to be it. She was in your shower. She was in  
4 your bathroom. She could have taken a, a pair of underwear. She could have  
5 taken some hair." I said, "You have..." At that point he didn't think she was that  
6 diabolical. I did. There was no reason for her to be there at that time of morning.  
7 And that's why I was going to suggest if n...if nobody has looked at the woods  
8 behind the Arden Villas, you might consider it. Now it's long after Caylee's  
9 missing.

10 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

11 **RG:** So I, I don't think so. Then again it's at the point I don't know. After reading your  
12 documents I've come to a different perception of Casey Anthony.

13 **YM:** In the time that she was uhm, I guess getting along with your family and coming  
14 over, as far as work is concerned the, did you, did, what did she say she did for a  
15 living?

16 **RG:** She worked at Kodak. Well and uhm, when it was Kodak.

17 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

18 **RG:** And the reason I know that, she helped my younger son, Chris, get a job there.  
19 And when my family would go to the park a couple of times she'd back door them  
20 into like The Mummy.

21 **YM:** When was, when was the last time that you actually spoke, uh, that, that Casey  
22 actually came to your house uh, to be with you or Jesse or the family? Do you  
23 remember when that was, the last time you would have seen her?

1 **RG:** Yeah (affirmative). That would have been uh, either late April or early May of '06  
2 (inaudible). I'd have to look at when to see graduation was for Dr. Phillips High  
3 School in May of '06.

4 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

5 **RG:** Because that would have been the week we saw her. She came by to, to have  
6 Casey, Caylee babysat. She was supposed to meet us at the Civic Center and  
7 never showed up. And that was the last time we ever saw her.

8 **YM:** Okay. Did she ever call you uh, on her own, or ask you and say hey, you know,  
9 how are you? Or did she ever call you personally or....

10 **RG:** No....

11 **YM:** ...not Jesse?

12 **RG:** ...she would, she would talk to me when she came to the house because Jesse  
13 would be late on a call for Progressive so she'd sit at the table and just chit-chat.

14 **YM:** What about uh, what about your wife? Did your wife have any relationship with  
15 Casey anything above and beyond maybe what you guys had?

16 **RG:** No. Just about the same. About the same.

17 **JA:** Uhm, and I, I stepped out for a few minutes. But I just have a couple questions.  
18 Uhm, did you ever hear that of, of any uh, uhm, uh, problems between Casey or  
19 Cindy the day before uhm, she turned up missing?

20 **RG:** The only thing I heard of was from Jesse from Lee.

21 **JA:** And....

22 **RG:** And at that point we don't know if he was telling us the truth.

23 **JA:** What did Lee...

24 **RG:** (Inaudible)...

25 **JA:** ...what did, what did, what did Lee tell Jesse?

1 **RG:** What Lee had told Jesse uhm, was that that fight the night before had escalated  
2 to the point that uh, Cindy had wrapped her hands around Casey's throat and  
3 was trying to strangle her.

4 **JA:** Okay, Lee told this to Jesse?

5 **RG:** Jesse, right.

6 **JA:** Okay. Did uh, uh, did Jesse ever tell you about any other incidents that, that in,  
7 uh, where, where Cindy and Casey had (inaudible).

8 **RG:** That was the only one that I had heard of. That was...

9 **JA:** Okay.

10 **RG:** ...the only one that I heard.

11 **JA:** Okay.

12 **RG:** And at that point, that's, that such bombshell stuff, I didn't know, we weren't sure  
13 if Lee was telling the truth or not. And also, and this may sound naïve, we were  
14 kind of trying to stay on the inside.

15 **JA:** Right. Did Lee ever tell, or I'm sorry, did uh, Jesse ever tell you uhm, anything  
16 about Lee and, and Casey's relationship?

17 **RG:** The only thing I heard and it was an odd relationship. It was kind of a, a (sighs),  
18 uh, well when I first met Lee in uh, '06...

19 **JA:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

20 **RG:** ...he's not the same young man...

21 **JA:** Right.

22 **RG:** ...he is now. He's very quiet. Very withdrawn. Very uhm, off. You know, he's a,  
23 a Star Wars geek.

24 **JA:** Okay.

25

1 **RG:** The other thing I heard was that, that that uh, they, they had a, yeah (affirmative),  
2 I don't want to say a love/hate relationship. But it, it, you know, what I'm hearing  
3 now is that oh, he was her protector. That was what I got.

4 **JA:** Alright. Uh, alright. Uh, now early on uh, when Casey became pregnant uhm,  
5 uh, she said that, that uh, Jesse was the father.

6 **RG:** Right.

7 **JA:** Was there every any conversation after, after that as to who the father might be  
8 once uh, once the paternity test showed that uh, that Jesse was not the father?

9 **RG:** Uhm, the only conversation that ever came up, and she never had it with us,  
10 never, you know she never even, it just dawned on me she never even  
11 apologized for lying to us and implicating Jesse. Uhm, the story was is that he  
12 was a one night stand who lives someplace else. And it wasn't until a year later  
13 that we heard all he had died.

14 **JA:** Hmm.

15 **RG:** You know, uhm, my problem with the story was is when I first met Casey  
16 personally, it was early of '05.

17 **JA:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

18 **RG:** I want to say either, it would probably be June because Chris had just gotten out  
19 of school and she helped him get a job at Kodak.

20 **JA:** Yeah (affirmative).

21 **RG:** She came to our house to give Chris some paperwork for the job. Jesse came  
22 inside and I asked him who that was. He said, "Remember that girl I dated last  
23 year? That's her." I said, "Jesse, she's pregnant." "Oh, no, she, no, she's  
24 having some female problem." I said, "No, Jesse, I know when I see a pregnant  
25 woman. She's pregnant."



1 **JA:** Hmm.

2 **RG:** And then so she was lying about (inaudible). She never, she has never told  
3 anybody who the father was or uhm....

4 **JA:** What's your understanding of, of, of how uh, Cindy and George found out that  
5 Casey was pregnant? Did you ever hear how that happened or...

6 **RG:** What I heard offhand from, from Jesse afterwards was that finally Casey was  
7 showing to the point that they took her to the doctor and got that confirmed. And  
8 that would have been like July of '05.

9 **JA:** Okay. Did uh, I'm trying to think, uhm, Jesse ever tell you anything else about  
10 Casey uh, that you think's important to us? Would be important to us?

11 **RG:** Uh, (sighs), nothing that I haven't already seen in your notes about it.

12 **JA:** Jesse, Jesse ever talk to you about uh, any of his uh, uh, any of the people he  
13 went to the Academy with and their relationship with Casey, or did, did that  
14 ever...

15 **RG:** Well I knew about, I knew about the whole Rusciano thing before that blew up.

16 **JA:** How did you know about that?

17 **RG:** Uhm, what happened was after Jesse and Casey broke up the second time uh,  
18 he finally accepted the fact that she wasn't the person he, he thought she was or  
19 wanted her to be. Because when Jesse and Casey broke up in May of,  
20 May/June '06, I had already gone to her My Space page and saved two pages  
21 full of comments between he and a young man named Adam. Adam is  
22 another...

23 **JA:** Adam, Adam and who?

24 **RG:** Casey.

25 **JA:** Adam and Casey? Okay.

1 **RG:** Yeah (affirmative), and I don't know Adam's last name. I've been trying to find it.

2 **JA:** Right.

3 **RG:** The reason I've been trying to find it because he's another ex-cop, ex-boyfriend.

4 **JA:** Okay.

5 **RG:** He went to Academy and didn't make it through, or didn't make it through FTO.

6 **JA:** Okay.

7 **RG:** Uhm, and the, the comments started in uh, March of '05. And before they were  
8 even broken up the comments were lovey-dovey romantic, we're together. And  
9 then I realized uhm, her, she had already replaced Jesse.

10 **JA:** Okay.

11 **RG:** And I think with Rusciano, the only reason I knew about that after the fact was is  
12 Jesse had mentioned that he thought that uh, she might be dating Rusciano. But  
13 by that point he didn't care.

14 **JA:** Right.

15 **RG:** And then when he, it all came out, uhm, the fact that yeah (affirmative), but the  
16 only reason it came up again is his story that uh, they, they had met at a party,  
17 but really didn't know each other, which was not the truth. She, she knew him  
18 from uh, hanging out with the guys while Jesse was at Academy.

19 **JA:** Okay. Did Jesse ever indicate to you at any time you know, that uh, uhm, you  
20 know that uh, Casey had problems as a child with her parents or none of that?

21 **RG:** Just in, just the stuff that I already knew about the constant fighting with her  
22 mother.

23 **JA:** Okay.

24

1 **RG:** Because Jesse uh, one night had gotten into it with, with Cindy at the house over  
2 him being there too late, and Cindy, Cindy went crazy. She started screaming at  
3 him, you know...

4 **JA:** At...

5 **RG:** ...dropping the F bomb.

6 **JA:** At Jesse?

7 **RG:** Yeah (affirmative).

8 **JA:** When was that?

9 **RG:** Phew, Caylee was born. So that would have to be after she was born, probably  
10 uhm, late '05, early '06.

11 **JA:** Okay. Alright. (Sighs.) Alright.

12 **RG:** Now the only thing I found interesting in, in this uh, situation with Casey reaching  
13 out to Jesse, I asked him this yesterday. I said going over all the notes and the  
14 timelines, I said, "Jesse, why did Casey reach out to you for a gas can two days  
15 after the car's already broken down?" He said, "What do you mean?" I said,  
16 "According to Amscot," and I had just read the reports, I said, "That car had  
17 already been there for two days and all of her friends are in town. Nobody's  
18 gone. Tony's there. Why is she asking you for a gas can?" And he said, "I don't  
19 know." He said, "But I didn't, I didn't do it." She wanted to drive all the way to the  
20 house to borrow your gas can and come back." He goes, "Why does that bother  
21 you?" I said, "I'm going to tell you why it bothers me." I said, "If this girl was  
22 actively trying implicate you. She wanted your fingerprints on her car.

23 **JA:** Hmm. Well we just need to sit down with Jesse and, and talk through a lot of this  
24 stuff (inaudible) what, what we're going to need to do, so.

25

1 **YM:** We're uhm, I don't know if you talked about the airplane that we're trying to  
2 facilitate that.

3 **JA:** No, and I actually talked to Savage, so just whenever we finish up we'll talk about  
4 that.

5 **YM:** Okay.

6 **RG:** Does Jesse, Jesse have a problem?

7 **JA:** No, no. We, we...

8 **YM:** No.

9 **JA:** ...we're trying to get him here.

10 **RG:** Okay.

11 **JA:** So we need to talk to him.

12 **RG:** Alright.

13 **YM:** The only thing, the, again, my reason, the reason that I called him and uh, I  
14 guess the reason he called you and you got involved is that whenever somebody  
15 gives a statement, especially in the (inaudible), and then normally in a statement  
16 in a case we like to get face-to-face, personal.

17 **RG:** Okay.

18 **JA:** Yeah (affirmative).

19 **YM:** We need to get it recorded or written. That's just...

20 **JA:** Yeah (affirmative).

21 **YM:** That's the way we, our rule of thumb. When, and when he gives information, if  
22 it's information that's new we need to do the same thing.

23 **RG:** Okay.

24 **YM:** Only because we can't explain later why we didn't do it. We don't have, we don't  
25 want to lend any doubt as to why we didn't take the opportunity or why, you

1 know, if he offered. And that's the reason I called. I didn't say you have to be  
2 here. I'm saying, hey, listen, you....

3 **JA:** Yeah (affirmative).

4 **YM:** ...you've offered it.

6 think anybody really knows what they're dealing with with Casey Anthony.  
7 Casey's not home. You're not dealing with Casey Anthony.

8 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

18 **YM:** Okay.

19 **RG:** And I know he's in town because his My Space page has been updated.

20 **YM:** And....

21 **RG:** He went to Colonial High School with Casey.

22 **YM:** How does his name come up, in what respect, aside from the obvious,

23 Sawgrass..

1 **RG:** I've been work, uhm, like I said, I've been working with Padilla and his guy Rob.  
2 And we've been bouncing ideas off each other. And both Rob and I said there's  
3 got to be somebody involved we don't know about. Casey's not this smart.  
4 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
5 **RG:** Even if she is the one who did it she's not this smart. And uh, uhm, so, so we  
6 began to look for names that hadn't appeared. And his name just suddenly  
7 jumped out. There's a guy named, well Sean Daly, you interviewed him?  
8 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
9 **RG:** Well, if you go to his M... he has a bunch of My Spaces pages.  
10 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

5 **RG:** ...and Snow.

6 **JA:** Alright.

7 **YM:** Did Jesse mention he knew any of these people personally?

8 **RG:** No. He, he uh, he didn't mention any of them. I was the one uhm, I, I don't know  
9 who it was that asked him Jesse were you in Casey's area? Somebody saw

1 **RG:** 321-202-6398.

2 **YM:** And that's off his website?

3 **RG:** That was off of a uh, I'll send you the link. We'll actually I saved all the

4 comments.

5 **YM:** Yeah (affirmative), if could give me those back.

6 **RG:** In case he goes back and deletes them all.

7 **YM:** That'd be great.

8 **RG:** And the other thing I found interesting about Dante, in Sean's statement to

9 you....

10 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

11 **RG:** He said that the last time he saw Casey was at a Wild Wings in Alafaya Trail.

12 **YM:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

13 **RG:** That's where Dante holds his muscle car parties. I thought that was really uh,

14 that kind of jumped out at me.

**Sermon Title: "Amazing Things" Part 3**

**Sermon Text: Joshua 3:1-17**

**Speaker: Bro. Jimmy Hurd, Minister**

Key Text: "Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do amazing things among you." Joshua 3:5

The people are at the Jordan River. Joshua sends two men into Jericho as spies. They are protected by the woman, Rahab. She let the spies know that they had heard of Israel. The spies went back and let Joshua know this.

Today's lesson:

Read Joshua 3:3-13

When you read the rest of the story – the priests do carry the Ark of the Covenant and stood firm on dry ground in the middle of the Jordan River, while the people of the nation of Israel crossed.

Six things we can do to put ourselves in a position to witness and be beneficiaries of God's amazing things. God does amazing things so we can see – it makes us go "WOW!"

**To witness amazing things...**

1. **We must put God first.**

Read Joshua 3:3. What was the Ark of the Covenant? It was a box/chest, made of acacia wood; about 3 feet long (see Exodus 25). God tells the people to bring Him

an offering. Read Exodus 25:8 The Ark of the Covenant sat in the most holy place of the tabernacle. Only the high priest could go in there. Read Exodus 25:22. The ark represented a place where God's presence would be known. The Ark contained: a golden pot of manna, 2 tablets upon which the Ten Commandments were written, and Aaron's rod. The Ark symbolized the presence of God. It was to be carried before the people and in front of the people. It symbolizes that God is out front, is present and is first. We need to put God first in our lives.

2. **Get moving.**

Read Joshua 3:3. Someone once said, "God cannot steer a parked car." If you want God to steer you, you need to get going.

God told Abram to go – Abram didn't even know where he was going.

3. **Seek God's guidance (every step of the way).**

Read Joshua 3:4. We can experience God's wonder each and every day of our lives. We study scripture so we will know what God wants us to do. We need to follow God every step of the way.

4. **Be willing to travel in unknown territory.**

Read Joshua 3:4. God was about to bless them with the land of Canaan.

We have to be pioneers – willing to blaze trails where we've never been before.

We tend to like sidewalks and clear paths. We have to get out of our comfort zone and know that the Lord will be with us.

5. **Worship, respect and honor God.**

Read Joshua 3:4. The scripture tells us that the Ark was to go in front, but also maintain a certain distance. That distance is a demonstration of respect – recognize the power of God. God wants us to be near to us. We should recognize His ever abiding presence. It helps our faith to grow – we recognize how powerful He is. We need to worship, respect, and honor Him.

6. **Prepare yourself to receive God's blessing.**

Read Joshua 3:5. We need to set ourselves apart. We need to make ourselves ready for God to do something great. There's a sense of expectation and preparing of you for God's greatness.

The people of Israel were willing to go to this unknown place.

Let's pray: Dear Heavenly Father, we thank you for the amazing things that you do in our lives. The food we eat, the clothes we wear, the roof over our heads is amazing, because you didn't have to provide it for us. Help us Father as we strive to put you first in our lives. If we are parked, help us to get going. We need you Father in every decision that we make and on each path that we travel. As we go into unknown territory we know that you are there with us. We will worship, respect and honor you Father. Father, God we accept your blessings. We truly anticipate what you have in store for us. Thank you most of all for your Son. It is in Jesus name that we do pray, Amen.

My name is Mae Kirk but my friends call me Chiqui. I'm writing to you because I thought you could use a little company even if only in a letter.

I have become drawn to your family because they seem like a bunch of good people not too different from mine.

I watched the memorial for Caylee and of course I cried.

When your dad said that he would like people to write to you, I thought okay, that's all I needed to know.

I have to tell you about the afternoon before Caylee's birthday. I wanted to send a birthday card but I wasn't sure if I should, I thought maybe God would give me a sign. It was a beautiful day the sun was shining but all of a sudden we had a thunder storm. It rained buckets! My daughter called me from Albertson's where she was working to ask me to pick her up. There was a loud clap of lightning and the phone crackled so I told her

wait until it subsided because I didn't want to be electrocuted. When the rain stopped I went to pick her up and as I turned into the parking lot there was a bright rainbow arching right over the lot! My daughter saw it and pointed out there was another rainbow just under the bright one --- two rainbows!

Well I took it as a sign. I found a card that was perfect even though the store was closing for good and there were hardly any to choose from.

It was a gorgeous scene with a unicorn a castle and a rainbow on the cover and it said simply "Once upon a time a beautiful little princess was born, and she filled the world with happiness and light."

You know I believe that rainbow was an assurance from God that Caylee was alright. The second rainbow must be for you. You'll be alright too.

My stepfather died one week after on August 16th. He had a heart attack all of a sudden. No warning, I tried to give him CPR, but he never regained consciousness. We were all grieving his death.

Your mother sent a thank you card with a picture of Caylee, I was really touched.

My dad was always great with kids I'm sure he and Caylee are surrounded by love, in heaven and pleased to make each others acquaintance. I hope you are holding up well.

I had to spend about 20 days in jail back in 2000. It was over a domestic violence incident. Luckily I was not convicted so I can still vote, yay!

There was this girl named Berlinda who had the bunk over top of mine she had the ugliest feet with five ~~inch~~ toe nails every morning I'd see them hanging over my head.

There were around 20 women in



the cell with me. I got to know a little bit about all of them.

I like to sing so I used to sing and sometimes the ladies would make a request. I remember once a girl wanted me to sing "Miss American Pie" so I did and we all got up and danced.

I like to draw portraits also so I bought a sketch pad and started drawing some of my cell mates. One afternoon I was drawing Sara, she was a beautiful fair skinned red head, when another girl from a different cell came over to us and asked me if I could draw her. She was pretty also but she was as dark and muscular as Wesley Snipes (he was in Blade and Passenger 57.) Anyway I said sure.

As I was drawing her she looked at me with this serious face so to lighten up the atmosphere I said, "You know if you smile it might come out better because if I get scared my hands going to start shaking!"

She Laughed. Whew!

After a while I had drawn a few of my cell mates and they were quite happy then Berlinda with the five inch toe nails asked me to draw her.

I didn't mention that she looked alot like the grinch that stole Christmas did I.

Anyway I said sure. Well every body gathered around to see how I was going to make her look.

I basically drew her but kept the Grinch in mind so as to make her somewhat cute. it worked. Everybody said yep! that's Berlinda.

What a week it has been for me. I am all registered for school and will have a full schedule for the next 8-weeks. I cannot tell you how excited I am. As a wife and mother, my family has always been first. It is my time to put myself first and with that comes a tad bit of guilt. However, I am thrilled that I will finally be working towards my college degree.

Today is my fathers 78<sup>th</sup> Birthday. They had a large celebration in Utah. My father has no idea how lucky to be as healthy as he is for his age. He has claimed to be very sick for the last 20-years and I cannot count how many times he told me he wasn't going to make it much longer. He is in better health than most men his age. In fact, my father farmed 600- acres of land and farm animals until 2-years ago when he was offered a nice sum of money from a builder. It was a bitter sweet moment for him. It is sad to watch beautiful land being turned into industrial areas. My poor brother had to deal with the closing of the farm. It was a big job getting rid of all the livestock and machinery. He also used to board animals for other people and they had to find another place to take their loved ones.

My son stopped in Utah to spend sometime with his sisters before heading to 29-palms, California. He has enjoyed his visit but is in a hurry to get to his final destination. Matthew doesn't like to leave things undone or being unsettled. He wants to get to the base and settle in so he has a place to call home. I wish he would find a nice girl and commit to a relationship. However, he is the least bit interested. First of all he is very shy. I will just have to be patient and pray that God brings the right person into his life at the perfect time.

My daughter Britany and her husband Nick moved into their new place this week. My husband and I purchased them a new couch as a housewarming gift. She selected a blue/gray microfiber L-shaped couch. I think the color blue is making a comeback. I actually redecorated my room about six months ago and selected blue, gray, yellow, and mint green for the colors. I took the colors from a landscape print by Claude Monet. My husband loves his artwork but I am not a fan. I wanted to try and decorate the room to both of our likings. If it were me – I would have picked vintage pinks with beautiful flowers. Now wouldn't that be something for him to see when he returns from Iraq? I actually purchased my first bedroom set in 26-years of marriage on my wedding anniversary. We could never afford one before. I am so excited for my husband to see it when he comes home in a couple of weeks. Yes, Tobey gets R&R and will be home in two weeks to see me. I am so excited to see him and so are my furry boys. We always do everything as a family but we decided that we would not fly the children out during his R&R. We want to spend some time alone. However, I am flying Tobey's best friend, Henry who lives in Colorado, to see Tobey while he is home. I decided that I would fly to Utah to see my children for a few days while Tobey is home and Henry is visiting. When Tobey drops me off at the airport we will have Henry standing there waiting for

Tobey – a surprise visit. I know it will be a wonderful surprise and this way they can spend some “guy” time together. They are both very strong Christians and they love the Lord. They will keep out of trouble.

I think I told you that my furry boy, Charlie, has arthritis. Well, he loves sports and he hasn't been able to play. The weather was warm for a few days so I decided to buy a soccer ball and play with the boys. Bad idea... Charlie was in so much pain from playing. Therefore, we are back to boring walks everyday. Bless his heart. I hate that fact that he is handicapped and can no longer do what he enjoys. When Matthew and Hanah were younger they played competitive soccer. Charlie used to go to practices and the kids loved it when he played soccer with them. He actually knew how to make a goal. It was so sweet. Billy, my border collie, is a herder by genetics. Therefore, he would run behind the children and Charlie and nip their feet like he was herding them. I sure do love my boys, Casey.

I have a busy agenda for this week. I have an eye appointment (I have had floaters) and so I need a full eye exam. I also need new prescription sunglasses because I broke my favorite pair. In addition, I am trying to get my house in perfect order so Tobey is impressed when he comes home. I moved to the military base when he left and he hasn't seen our place yet. I hope the weather is nice because I am going to build some flower boxes for my patio. I am not allowed to put up a fence but thought I would build the boxes and then nail a small picket fence to the boxes. I thought it would add character to the patio. I plan on planting a full vegetable garden this year. Also, I ordered some beautiful rose bushes for the front yard. I have had two sisters that have passed away. My sister Shirley had brain cancer and passed away when I was a couple years old. Then my sister Joyce passed away of a stroke 5-years ago at the age of 41-years old. They both loved yellow roses. Therefore, I try to plant a yellow rose bush wherever I am living. In fact, Joyce's 5-year anniversary since her death is approaching in a couple of days. Joyce was very intelligent and successful but she became addicted to prescription drugs. Her stroke was actually a result of her years of drug abuse and cigarette smoking. She was homeless on several occasions; something I didn't know until her death. Therefore, during the month of February and March I try to bless the homeless or people that appear to be struggling by handing them a few dollars when I see them. I just fold it up in my hand and discreetly give it to people I think could use it. My sister had so many problems but by the grace of God her children have done well. My nephew, Bryant, is attending West Point on a full academic scholarship and my niece Carmella is earning her Masters Degree at the University of Utah. Not bad for two children that lived a less than desirable life. I will always feel ashamed for not being around for my sister and her family when they needed me most. (I am including an article about Bryant. I think it states he was going to Notre Dame. He was but then was offered another scholarship at West Point)

Casey, I have printed some articles out for you to read. I hope you received the book I sent. I will be sending you another book in a few weeks called, “Goodbye is not forever.” This is an excellent book about a young girl that grew-up under the leadership

of Hitler and Stalin. The book is very heartwarming. Keep in mind that the first chapter is not very good. I skipped past the first chapter and started with the second.

I want you to know that you are in my daily thoughts and prayers. Stay positive, keep your head up high, and remember who you are. Oh, this reminds me, read the article about the Levy case. Remember when Congressman, Gary Condit was accused of her death? He lost reelection and his entire life was taken from him. God is good, Casey. The truth has finally surfaced and they found the person responsible for her death. It is shameful the Condit family had to go through so much. I am sure it doesn't surprise you that I haven't heard any apologies to his family or to him. It's easy to be cynical but when the truth bares itself people like Nancy Grace and her groupies can't seem to take the time to apologize for making false accusations. This article will give you hope. Pray, Casey, you will be vindicated.

## Levy family's grief endures, despite break in case

In the first weeks after her only daughter disappeared, grief hit Susan Levy so hard she could not move from a fetal position on the living room couch.

By the time Chandra Levy's skull and bones were found in a park in the nation's capital a year later, her mother had found enough strength to dial Washington police detectives to ask why it was taking so long to find her daughter's killer.

Now, eight years after Chandra's death, Susan Levy said the sudden news late Friday that police planned to arrest a Salvadoran immigrant in the slaying may resolve the crime, but it will do nothing to stem her family's heartache.

"This helps a little," said Levy, staring listlessly in the den of her central California home. "But we still don't have our daughter and we have a life sentence without her. Grief is like a marathon. You don't get over it. It recycles itself."

Chandra Levy was 24 and had just completed an internship with the U.S. Bureau of Prisons when she disappeared in May 2001 after leaving her Washington, D.C., apartment.

After authorities questioned her congressman, Gary Condit, in the disappearance and revealed his affair with Levy, media from around the world descended on the family's split-level home amid the orchards of Modesto, a sleepy city 90 miles east of San Francisco.

Susan, her husband Bob and their son Adam retreated, and drew the blinds hoping to cope with their anguish in peace.

Another mother, Donna Raley, rang their doorbell to offer support, and said she found Susan wasn't eating.

"She was somber, she was almost in a fetal position on that couch. I told her I, too, had lost a child and we sat and cried," Raley said. "I said she could either let whoever took her daughter take her and her marriage, too, or she could stand tall and fight back."

Bit by bit, Susan emerged with the help of Raley and other friends, and started leaving the house to practice yoga or ride her horses, anything to escape the television trucks parked in two single-file lines along their cul-de-sac.

Only a year after Chandra's disappearance on May 1, 2001, she and Raley founded a nonprofit advocacy group called Wings of Protection to help family members of violent crime victims who are missing.

Then, after bungled searches by the D.C. police came the news that a dog walker had discovered Chandra's remains under the forest canopy of Rock Creek Park in May 2002.

The family's hopes that she might still be alive were extinguished.

"We used to pray for her to have a happy life, and a fulfilling career," said her father Bob Levy, an oncologist. "We started praying for her to be reincarnated."

Hobbled by pain, the couple explored Buddhism, Hinduism and Christianity, and Chandra's father began keeping a log of signs that his daughter's spirit was present — small things, such as a rainbow after a storm, or her godmother's dream that Chandra wanted to send her parents a message.

They also looked for solace in Modesto's close-knit Jewish community, he said.

Each Yom Kippur, the holiest day in the Jewish calendar, they would fast and pray at Congregation Beth Shalom for those who had passed. And each year, the congregation would light a candle in Chandra's name and bring out a special, small Torah donated by the Levys, a collection of sacred scrolls of Hebrew Scriptures smuggled out of Germany during the Holocaust.

"We all call it the Levy Torah, and everyone feels it's an honor to hold it because it's a reminder of the recent death of Chandra," said Joyce Gandelman, a leader at the synagogue who sings with Susan in the choir. "She hasn't left Modesto. Chandra's spirit is still here."

Photos of the young intern adorn the home where she grew up.

Her parents still take sleeping pills to get through the night, though her mother said therapy has been of some help.

But as with many families struggling with the slow course of the justice system, the Levys have been largely left alone to work through their unanswered questions.

"I was hoping the detectives would call once a month and I would get an update," Susan Levy said. "But it's probably, three, four, five months and you don't hear anything from them."

Friday night's breakthrough call from Washington, D.C., Police Chief Cathy Lanier came as a surprise, she said.

"For a minute there, I felt energized and ecstatic hearing that a warrant would be served, just knowing that someone is doing something, that they hadn't forgotten about me," Susan Levy said.

Family friend Pat Hall's eyes lit up when she was told there was a break in the case.

"It was tough, hard not knowing anything, not having any answers," she said. "We all had our suspicions, which obviously were wrong, and it cost congressman Condit his job."

The Levys won't talk about Condit. The former Democratic congressman from Ceres, Calif., put out a statement after news reports surfaced that Washington, D.C., police were preparing an arrest warrant for Ingmar Guandique. The 27-year-old inmate is serving a sentence in a federal prison in Adelanto, Calif., for attacks on two women in Rock Creek Park in 2001.

D.C. police spokesman Officer Quintin Peterson said Sunday that he could not comment on the investigation. Avis Buchanan, director of the Washington, D.C., Public Defender Service, said in an e-mail that her office is still representing Gaundique, but the lawyer who was previously assigned to him is no longer with the office.

"For the Levy family, we are glad they are finally getting the answers they deserve," Condit said in a statement to the Washington television station WJLA. "For my family, I am glad that their years of standing together in the face of such adversity have finally led to the truth."

Saturday, after hours of interviews, an exhausted Susan Levy said she was doing all she could to honor her daughter's passion for justice and law enforcement.

"We are just one family that has gone through this. How many other families have cold cases that are unsolved and are still looking for answers?" she said. "This is bittersweet. I still don't know if justice will be done."

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## Mice overrun Fla. courthouse, fall from ceiling

There are so many mice in one Florida county courthouse that they've been seen falling from ceiling tiles.

One judge at the Palm Beach County Courthouse calls it an infestation. Some staffers say they check their handbags for stowaways before leaving the building each day.

Court employees and lawyers say the rodents scuttle down corridors, munch legal papers and scratch behind the walls. Last week, one mouse ran around a courtroom floor for an hour during a burglary trial.

The courthouse facilities manager says he's put out a few dozen traps to capture the rodents. He says he's not sure there has been an uptick in mice lately but says they're getting more press than they deserve.

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# Kyrgyzstan issues eviction notice to key US base

The United States was on the verge of being kicked out of its only military outpost in Russia's historic backyard after Kyrgyzstan Friday gave U.S. forces six months to vacate an air base that serves as a key supply hub for troops in Afghanistan.

The Manas base, created shortly after the September 11, 2001 attacks in the United States, at first served as a symbol of what seemed like a budding strategic partnership between the U.S. and Russia.

But as relations between the two countries soured in recent years, the base came to represent the renewed competition between the two former Cold War rivals.

Maj. Damien Pickart, a spokesman for the U.S. base, said he expected military officials to begin preparations for leaving.

"If they tell us that our time is up — which they've done today — then we'll start the necessary preparations to move operations," he added. "I don't know if it will take the full six months," he said.

Pakistani militants have stepped up attacks on convoys traveling the primary supply route to Afghanistan in recent months, pushing U.S. officials to secure alternative, northern routes through Central Asia. Manas was a vital link, serving as a transit point for 15,000 U.S. troops and 500 tons of cargo each month.

Kyrgyzstan's president announced the U.S. ouster from Manas shortly after Moscow promised \$2.1 billion in loans and aid to the tiny, impoverished Central Asian country. Russia insists that it did not influence the decision.

Although the U.S. insists that there is time to strike a deal to keep Manas open, Washington is trying to come up with replacement routes for men and materiel moving to and from the mountains of Afghanistan.

"I continue to believe this is not a closed issue, and that there remains the potential to reopen this issue," U.S. Defense Secretary Robert Gates said Friday. "But we are developing alternative methods of getting resupply and people into Afghanistan."

One obvious alternative could be Uzbekistan, where the U.S. had a military air base supporting the Afghan conflict in 2001-2005.

The commander of U.S. operations in Afghanistan and Iraq, Gen. David Petraeus, traveled to the Uzbek capital, Tashkent, earlier this week to meet with President Islam Karimov. No details of his visit were released.

On Friday U.S. Rear Admiral Mark Harnitchek said that Uzbekistan had reached a deal for cargo to be shipped across its territory.

"We have a tentative agreement with Uzbekistan on transit," he said during a visit to neighboring Tajikistan. His comments were shown on Tajik state television.

Some of the goods will be transported from Uzbekistan onward through Tajikistan, which also shares a direct border with Afghanistan, Harnitchek said.

The U.S. in August 2007 opened a \$37 million bridge over the Pyandzh River, which forms most of the border between Tajikistan and Afghanistan.

"We plan to move between 50 and 200 containers to Afghanistan through Tajikistan every week," Harnitchek said.

Washington has already reached similar agreements with Russia and Kazakhstan.

But the tentative pact with Uzbekistan was particularly important. It represented a warming of relations between U.S. officials and Uzbekistan's authoritarian president.

Karimov ordered a major U.S. air base in Uzbekistan closed in the wake of Washington's criticism of his government's deadly crackdown on anti-government protesters in the city of Andijan in 2005.

Activists fear that, in exchange for basing rights, the Obama administration could tacitly agree not to press Karimov to halt rights abuses.

Most of Karimov's opponents have been sent to jail or into exile. The U.S.-based Human Rights Watch has said that Uzbek prison authorities routinely abuse and torture prisoners.

"We have observed that in Uzbekistan, due to political and economic considerations, pressure on Karimov's government to uphold human rights has gradually decreased," said Igor Vorontsov, a Human Rights Watch researcher focusing on Uzbekistan.

"We are monitoring the situation carefully and urging the United States to take a principled position on human rights in Uzbekistan, no matter what military or other cooperation may reach," he said.

President Barack Obama announced earlier this week that he would send 17,000 more U.S. troops to Afghanistan to augment the 33,000 already there.

He'll put his 40-thousand dollar Ron Brown scholarship to good use at Notre Dame. It's a dream come true for a boy who, in spite of having few advantages, was determined to succeed at school.

Bryant Watson, Ron Brown Scholarship Recipient: "Growing up, I didn't have opportunities that lots of other kids had, in terms of having a stable home, stable school, going to the same school. I went to nine different elementary schools. That was pretty tough."

Bryant's mother raised him and his sister, Carmela, all by herself, until her untimely death two years ago.

Carmela Willden, U of U student: "Of course my mother's death when I was a junior was extremely hard, but I knew I had to get through it to achieve my goals."

Tuffy Watson, a counselor at West high, and his wife took the pair into his own family and encouraged them onward, Bryant at West High and Carmela a Larry Miller scholarship recipient at the U.

Bryant Watson: "You know he's just always been positive, encouraged me to apply for scholarships. I went to Cornell. He helped me get out there. I studied there last summer. Just really positive with everything I've done."

"Tuffy" Watson, West High Counselor: "I use them as an example all the time when I talk with kids and tell them, 'You know, if you want to do something with your life here are two children who've had it rough as anybody I've ever known, and they've succeeded.'"

And Watson says this dynamic duo will continue to succeed and to show others they can too.

"Tuffy" Watson: "Only once in a lifetime do you get to meet certain special people, and these are two of the special people that I've met in my life."

Bryant has been admitted to the US Military Academy at West Point, but he says he will study engineering and political science at Notre Dame. Carmela hopes to get either a masters degree or a law degree someday.
